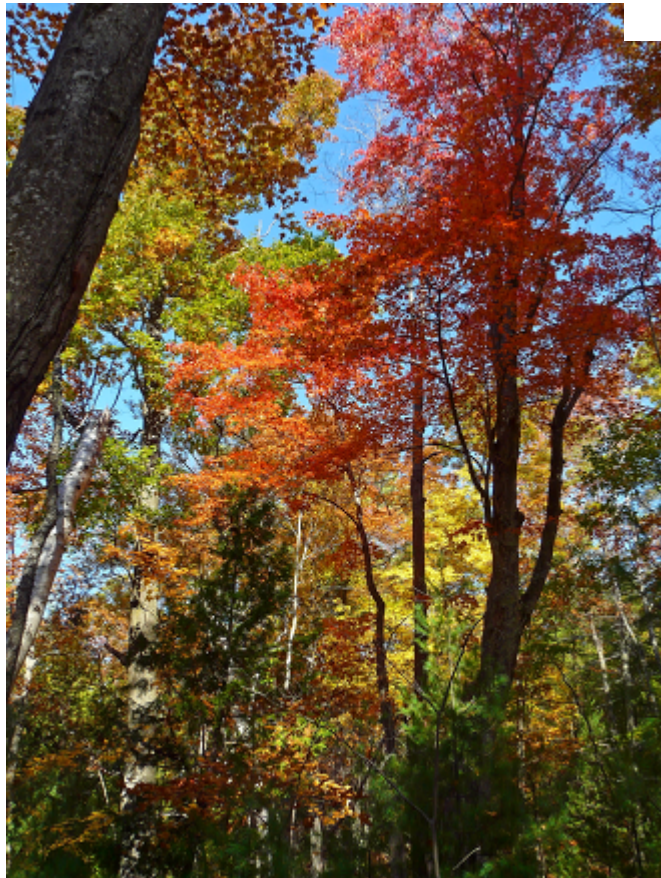

The decline in Finland's forest products output seen through the first three quarters of 2023 continued into Q4, according to the Finnish Forest Industries Federation (FFIF).
